


JUST TRANSITION









FOR A JUST TRANSITION IN THE WASTE SECTOR, THE VOICE OF THE WORKERS NEED TO BE HEARD. THE WASTE PICKERS FROM KARNATAKA ARE UNITING TO DEMAND A JUST TRANSITION FROM THE GOVERNMENTS AT NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL LEVELS. IN MARCH 2022, THE THYAJYA SHARMIKA SANGHA OR TSS CAME INTO EXISTENCE. IT IS A REGISTERED UNION REPRESENTING OVER 25,000 WASTE PICKERS AND RECYCLERS ACROSS KARNATAKA.

IN THE CLIMATE CHAMPION'S TRAINING CONDUCTED BY HASIRU DALA IN 2022, THE WASTE PICKERS FROM KARNATAKA PUT FORTH A LIST OF 11 JUST TRANSITION DEMANDS. THESE WERE IN LINE WITH THE DEMANDS RAISED BY THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANISATION (ILO)

ESSENTIAL COMPONENTS OF JUST TRANSITION:

THE INTERNATIONAL ALLIANCE OF WASTE PICKERS (TAWP'S POSITION, PAPER- VISION ON JUST TRANSITION) HAS PUT FORWARD 9 ESSENTIAL COMPONENTS OF JUST TRANSITION-THEY ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. RECOGNITION OF WASTE PICKERS IN NORMS, POLICIES AND LAWS;
- 2. UNIVERSAL REGISTRATION OF WASTE PICKERS AND OTHER WORKERS IN PLASTIC VALUE CHAINS;
- 3. TRANSPARENCY, OVERSIGHT AND ADAPTATION;
- 4- DIRECT INVOLVEMENT AND ADVANCEMENT IN POLICY MAKING AND IMPLEMENTATION PROCESSES;
- 5. SOCIAL PROTECTIONS AND SAFEGUARDS;
- 6. FAIR REMUNERATION, LIVING WAGES AND SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS;
- 7. FORMALISATION AND STRENGTHENED ORGANISING;
- 8. CAPACITY BUILDING AND APPROPRIATE TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER;
- 9. IMPROVED MATERIALS MANAGEMENT.
